RULES FOR ONLINE GAMES

Purpose

These rules are the guidelines and regulations for the New Mexico Lottery Authority Online Games.

General Use and Applicability

These rules are applicable to New Mexico Lottery staff, retailers, vendors, and players.

Definitions

“Advance play” means a play for an eligible game purchased in advance for a future drawing that can be selected by the specific day of the week within seven (7) days of the purchase of the ticket.

“Board” or “NMLA Board” means the New Mexico Lottery Authority Board of Directors, as appointed pursuant to the New Mexico Lottery Act.

“Central system” or “on-line system” means the central computer system used to control and monitor the online gaming environment to which the terminals are connected by a communication medium authorized by the NMLA.

“CEO” means the Chief Executive Officer of the Lottery appointed by the Board pursuant to the New Mexico Lottery Act.

“Drawing” means the formal process of randomly selecting winning numbers in accordance with MUSL Group Drawing Procedures and the New Mexico Lottery On-line Games Drawing Procedures Manual.

“Exchange ticket” means a new ticket that is produced when cashing a winning prize on a multi-draw ticket in which there are any remaining plays on the ticket for future drawings.

“Game board” or “panel” means the area of the play slip that contains the numbered squares to be marked by the player. Each set of numbers on the play slip, marked by a letter, is considered a separate board.

“Game play” or “play” means the numbers that appear on a ticket produced by the terminal, as a single lettered selection and are to be played by a player in the game.

“Game ticket” or “ticket” means a play or plays produced that meet the specifications in the Ticket Validation section.

“Multi-draw” means a play for the current drawing plus a specified number of subsequent drawings. The number of future drawings available is determined at the sole discretion of the Lottery.

“MUSL” means the Multi-State Lottery Association, a government-benefit association wholly owned and operated by the Party Lotteries.

“New Mexico Lottery Authority”, “New Mexico Lottery”, “NMLA”, “Lottery”, or “Authority” means the New Mexico Lottery Authority, a public body, politic and corporate, separate and apart from

the state, constituting a governmental instrumentality, established and operated pursuant to the New Mexico Lottery Act.

“New Mexico Lottery Act”, “Lottery Act”, or “the Act” means the New Mexico Lottery Act, NMSA, 1978, Sections 6-24-1 through 6-24-34, as the same may be amended from time to time.

“Online lottery game” means a lottery game that is connected to a central computer via a communications system through which a player selects a specified group of numbers or symbols out of a predetermined range of numbers or symbols and purchases a ticket bearing the player-selected or computer-generated numbers or symbols for eligibility in a drawing regularly scheduled in accordance with game rules.

“Party Lottery” or “Member Lottery” means a state lottery or lottery of a political subdivision or entity that has joined MUSL and has joined in selling the games offered by MUSL.

“Play slip” means a card approved by the NMLA used in marking a player's game plays and containing one or more game boards.

“Prize expense” or “prize payout” means the percentage of sales expected to be paid out as prizes by game design.

“Prize fund” means the amount of money available from each game's ticket sales from which prizes are paid.

“Prize pool” means the prize expense recognized on an individual drawing and any amounts of previous prize expense not won and carried forward by game design.

“Product Group” means a group of lotteries that have joined together to offer a common product pursuant to the terms of the Multi-State Lottery Agreement and the Product Group's own rules.

“Quick pick” means the random selection of numbers by the on-line system which appears on a ticket and are played by a player in the game.

“Raffle” means a number-match game with a limited number of tickets available that will be sold within a limited sales period with set prizes that can be won.

“Retailer” or “Lottery Retailer” means a person or legal entity authorized by the NMLA to sell Lottery tickets pursuant to the New Mexico Lottery Act.

“Set prize” means a prize that is advertised to be paid by a single cash payment and, except in instances outlined in these rules, will be equal to the prize amount established by the NMLA and/or MUSL for the prize level.

“Terminal” or “Lottery terminal” means a device authorized by the NMLA to function in an online, interactive mode with the central system for the purpose of issuing lottery tickets and entering, receiving, and processing lottery transactions, including the purchasing of tickets, the validation of tickets, and the transmission of reports.

“Ticketless transaction” means plays sold through subscription, internet, or non-standard terminals. (See Terms and Conditions for Online Game Purchases)

“Ticket validation” means the process retailers use to determine if a game ticket is a winner.

“Winning numbers” means the numbers randomly selected at each drawing, which shall be used to identify winning plays contained on a game ticket for that drawing.

“Winning play” or “winning ticket” means a ticket produced in advance for a specific drawing which contains at least the minimum requisite number of matches to the winning numbers drawn for the corresponding drawing, that meets ticket validation requirements, and is validated by the central system.

Policy

1. Sale of On-Line Game Tickets

- a. Only Retailers who have entered into a Retailer contract with the NMLA and have been approved by the NMLA, at the NMLA’s sole discretion, for the sale of on-line games and the NMLA Claim Center, and any NMLA staff or designees assigned to NMLA promotional and special events, are authorized to sell on-line game tickets. On-line game tickets may only be sold at the Retailer business location(s) listed in the Retailer contract for which the NMLA has authorized the sale of tickets for on-line games, at a remote site as authorized by the NMLA, or as a properly and validly registered ticketless transaction play. Nothing contained herein shall prohibit the NMLA from selling tickets, conducting promotions, or conducting drawings at locations other than the Lottery headquarters.
- b. Each on-line game ticket shall sell for the retail sales price authorized by the CEO or as authorized by the CEO for promotional purposes.
- c. Retailers shall sell tickets for any and all on-line games, as directed by the NMLA.
- d. A ticket may be voided or cancelled only for those games designated by the NMLA. No ticket that can be used to claim a prize shall be returned to the Lottery for credit. If a player makes a selection on a play slip that is incorrect, the player may void that game board’s selection prior to its insertion into the terminal by marking the VOID box for that game board on the play slip.
- e. An exchange ticket is produced when cashing a prize on a multi-draw ticket in which there are any remaining plays on the ticket for future drawings.

2. Game Description

The Game Description for each on-line game shall be included as part of these rules and shall contain the following information:

- a. Game name;
- b. Retail sales price;
- c. Play style;
- d. Prize structure;
- e. Days of drawings.

3. Method of Playing an On-line Game

- a. The CEO or designee, subject to final approval by the CEO, shall determine the method of play for each game.

- b. Plays may be entered manually by a Retailer using the lottery terminal keypad, by means of a play slip provided by the NMLA and hand-marked by the player, or by such other means approved by the NMLA. Retailers shall not permit the use of facsimiles or copies of play slips or other materials that are inserted into the terminal play slip reader that are not printed or approved by the NMLA, nor shall they permit the use of any play slips that are not hand marked by the player. Retailers shall not permit any device to be connected to a lottery terminal to enter plays or for any other purpose, except as approved by the NMLA.
- c. Odds information available at Lottery Retailers provides odds of winning a prize in each on-line game. Detailed prize odds are posted on the New Mexico Lottery website at nm lottery.com.
- d. Additional information can be obtained from a Lottery Retailer, Lottery Customer Service at (505) 342-7600, or the NMLA website at nm lottery.com.

4. Ticket Validation

- a. An original game ticket shall be the only proof of a game play or plays and the submission of a winning ticket to the NMLA, or its authorized Retailer, shall be the sole method of claiming a prize or prizes. No copies or reproductions will be accepted for validation.
- b. The ticket must not be blank, mis-registered, defective, or printed or produced in error.
- c. The ticket must not be counterfeit or forged, in whole or in part.
- d. The ticket must not be mutilated, altered, unreadable, reconstituted, or tampered with in any manner.
- e. The ticket must be printed on ticket stock that meets the security requirements for ticket stock used for NMLA on-line games.
- f. Tickets may be purchased through a ticketless transaction process if properly and validly registered as a ticketless transaction play.
- g. The ticket must have been issued by the NMLA or authorized Retailer in an authorized manner.
- h. The ticket shall have been received or recorded by the NMLA by applicable deadlines.
- i. To be a valid ticket and eligible to receive a prize, a ticket shall satisfy all the requirements established by the NMLA for the sale, purchase, and validation of winning tickets sold through its on-line system. All winners, tickets and transactions are subject to NMLA rules, policies, procedures, and state law.
- j. Tickets reported and verified as stolen or obtained illegally will not be valid for claiming a prize.
- k. Liability for void, altered, or misprinted tickets, or disputes if any, is limited to the refund of the retail sales price.
- l. The ticket shall be validated according to validation procedures as determined by the NMLA prior to payment of a prize.
- m. A ticket which fails any of the NMLA's validation checks is invalid and ineligible for any prize and a prize shall not be paid.

5. Ticket Responsibility

- a. It shall be the sole responsibility of the player to verify the accuracy of the game play or plays and other data printed on the ticket. The placing of plays is done at the player's own risk through the Lottery Retailer who is acting on behalf of the player in entering the play or plays.
- b. A ticket is a bearer instrument until signed on the back by the ticket owner. Until a signature or mark is placed upon a ticket in the area designated for signature, the bearer of the ticket shall own the ticket. When a signature is placed on the ticket in the place designated, the person whose signature or mark appears in such area shall be the owner of the ticket and shall be entitled (subject to the requirements in –the Ticket Validation and Prize Payment sections) to any prize attributable thereto.
- c. Payment of prizes for valid winning tickets bearing multiple signatures shall be divided according to the percentages as agreed to in writing by the parties. The parties must agree on the percentages prior to the prize being paid.
- d. A receipt for a ticketless transaction play has no value and is not evidence of a play.
- e. The NMLA is not responsible for lost, stolen, misdirected, misprinted, misdispensed, or damaged tickets.
- f. The NMLA is not responsible for wagers recorded on the gaming system for which a ticket was not produced due to a telecommunications interruption.
- g. The NMLA is not obligated to resolve competing claims to winning tickets.
- h. The NMLA shall not be responsible for tickets claimed by a player in error for a lower prize at a Retailer.

6. Prize Payment

- a. All prizes must be claimed within ninety (90) calendar days of the drawing in which the prize was won. If the ninetieth (90th) calendar day falls on a day in which the NMLA is not open for business, then the ticket must be claimed on the first business day after the ninetieth (90th) calendar day. A ticket that is mailed must be received at the Lottery headquarters within ninety (90) calendar days of the drawing. If the NMLA is not open for business, then the ticket must be received the first business day after the ninetieth (90th) calendar day.
- b. A claim form shall be submitted by the winner(s) of prizes exceeding six hundred dollars (\$600). The claim form must be completely filled out and signed.
- c. If there are multiple claimants for the winning ticket, a representative, having a power of attorney, may complete and sign a claim form on the other claimant's behalf.
- d. If there are multiple claimants for a winning ticket and there is not a representative, having a power of attorney, then each claimant must submit a claim form.
- e. If the owner of a winning ticket is unable to complete a claim form due to a legal, physical, or other disability, then a guardian, conservator, custodian, fiduciary, or duly authorized representative, having a power of attorney, may complete and sign a claim form on the owner's behalf. The claim form shall indicate the name of the lawful payee.
- f. If the person signing the claim form is a personal representative of the estate of a deceased winner, that person shall submit his or her letter of administration or its legal equivalent showing the appointment from the court having jurisdiction over the estate.

- g. A person who signs a claim form shall be deemed to have represented that the information contained therein is accurate and complete.
- h. No incomplete claim form shall be processed for payment.
- i. Prizes of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or more must be claimed in person at Lottery headquarters.
- j. Payment of prizes of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) or more may be delayed for a period of several weeks, or more, from the date of validation of the original winning ticket.
- k. Prizes exceeding six hundred dollars (\$600) must be claimed at the Lottery, either at Lottery headquarters or by mail using a Lottery claim form.
- l. Prizes of six hundred dollars (\$600) or less may be claimed at any Lottery Retailer or mailed to: New Mexico Lottery; PO Box 93190; Albuquerque, NM 87199-3190. No claim form is required.
- m. The holder of a winning ticket may win only one prize per board in connection with the winning numbers drawn and shall be entitled only to the prize won by those numbers in the highest matching prize category, unless allowed by the specific Game Rules.
- n. The NMLA may not pay prizes to any claimant who purchased a ticket from an unauthorized Retailer.
- o. Prizes are not assignable, but prizes may be paid to a deceased winner's estate or to a person designated by judicial order.
- p. Under no circumstances will the NMLA pay a prize or share of a prize without the original ticket being presented to the NMLA.

7. Game Termination

The NMLA, at any time, may announce the termination date for an individual on-line game. If this occurs, no tickets shall be sold past the termination date. All advance play tickets and multi-draw tickets for that game shall be honored and drawings will continue until the last date for which tickets have been sold.

8. Applicable Law

In purchasing a ticket, the purchaser agrees to comply with and abide by all applicable laws, rules, regulations, policies, procedures, and decisions of the NMLA.

9. Purchase and Prize Restrictions

- a. No ticket may be purchased by and no prize shall be paid to anyone prohibited from purchasing or claiming a prize pursuant to the Lottery Act or any Product Group rules.

10. Taxes and Debt Setoffs

In accordance with the Lottery Act and subject to MUSL rules:

- a. Any Lottery prize is subject to applicable state and federal taxes. The NMLA shall report to the state and federal taxing authorities any lottery prize exceeding six hundred dollars (\$600). Prizes will be subject to tax withholding in accordance with applicable law.
- b. Prizes exceeding six hundred dollars (\$600) are subject to collection by the New Mexico Human Services Department.

11. Printed Play Slip

- a. The NMLA, or its authorized Retailers, may provide play slips at no cost to the players.
- b. Play slips are provided solely for the convenience of the players and shall have no pecuniary or prize value and shall not constitute evidence of ticket purchase or of numbers or symbols selected.
- c. If a play slip is used, the player shall select the requisite number of selections for each desired panel for that game.
- d. Facsimiles of play slips or copies of any original may not be used in place of Lottery approved play slips.
- e. Play slips may not be available for all games.

12. Drawings

- a. The NMLA shall approve the drawing procedures to be followed for each on-line game drawing in accordance with the Lottery Act. Alternate drawing procedures may be established for business continuity in the event of exigent circumstances.
- b. The number of drawings and drawing days for on-line games is established, and may be changed, upon approval by the CEO.
- c. The Lottery reserves the right to delay or cancel any drawing due to exigent circumstances if approved by the CEO or designee.

13. Dissemination of Winning Numbers Information

The dissemination and publication of winning numbers by telephone or in the media is for informational purposes only, and the NMLA shall not pay a prize based upon information obtained from winning number information lines or any source other than the official draw results as electronically recorded in the central system. The NMLA is not responsible for incorrect information provided by a Retailer or NMLA staff, telephonic or in person, or by any forms of media. Only tickets validated by the central system will be honored.

14. Promotional Prize Expense Exception

With written CEO approval, the NMLA may make temporary changes to the prize expense to change the on-line game prize structures and prize amounts for promotional purposes. When in effect, this section supersedes other rules related to prize expense.

15. Order of Precedence

These Rules shall be interpreted and applied in the following order of precedence:

- a. New Mexico Lottery Act;
- b. Multi-State Lottery Association Rules, Powerball Group Rules, and Lotto America Group Rules (as applicable);
- c. Party Lotteries or Mega Millions Group Rules;
- d. These Rules;
- e. Terms and Conditions for Online Game Purchases;
- f. NMLA On-Line Digital Drawing Procedures Manual.

16. MUSL Rules

MUSL Rules and specific game rules as may be adopted and amended are hereby incorporated.

17. Roadrunner Cash Game Description

Game Name: Roadrunner Cash

Retail Sales Price: \$1

Play Style: Five (5) of thirty-seven (37)

Prize Structure: The following table sets forth the probability of winning and the probable distribution of winners in and among each prize category, based upon the total number of possible combinations in Roadrunner Cash.

Drawings: Roadrunner Cash drawings are held nightly seven (7) nights a week from Sunday through Saturday but may be changed at the discretion of the CEO.

Expected Prize Payout: The advertised Jackpot is an estimate of the actual Jackpot and is pari-mutuel. The remaining prizes are set prizes; however, some or all may become pari-mutuel under certain circumstances.

Roadrunner Cash Top Prize: The minimum starting Jackpot for Roadrunner Cash will be \$25,000.

For estimated advertised Jackpot amounts over \$25,000, up to and including \$250,000, the Lottery will as a matter of practice pay the estimated advertised Jackpot absent of any sales or system anomalies or any Acts of God.

If the estimated advertised Jackpot is more than \$250,000, the Lottery will pay the actual Jackpot amount, but no less than the estimated advertised Jackpot, absent of any sales or system anomalies or any Acts of God.

For purposes of this policy, the advertised Jackpot will be paid when generated sales for that draw are sufficient to fund the advertised Jackpot within 5% +/- . In the event the actual sales for that draw fail to achieve, or the actual sales exceed, required levels to fund the advertised estimated Jackpot amount by more than 5%, then the actual amount shall be paid.

Cancellations: Roadrunner Cash tickets cannot be cancelled.

Roadrunner Cash Software Requirements Specifications: The current and official Roadrunner Cash Software Requirements Specifications and any future modifications shall become part of these rules.

18. Powerball Game Description

Powerball Group Rules: The current and official Multi-State Lottery Association Rules and Powerball Group Rules and any future modifications shall become part of these rules. Refer to the Powerball Group Rules.

Game Name: Powerball

Retail Sales Price: \$2

Play Style: Five (5) of sixty-nine (69) of the first set plus one (1) of twenty-six (26) from the second set, referred to as the “Powerball”

Prize Structure: The following table sets forth the probability of winning and the probable distribution of winners in and among each prize category, based upon the total number of possible combinations in Powerball.

Drawings: Powerball drawings are held Wednesday and Saturday evenings.

Expected Prize Payout: The Grand Prize shall be determined on a pari-mutuel basis. Except as provided in the Powerball Group Rules, all other prizes awarded shall be paid as set prizes.

Grand Prize/Jackpot: The prize money allocated from the current Powerball prize pool for the Grand Prize, plus any previous portions of prize money allocated to the Grand Prize category in which no matching tickets were sold, will be divided equally among all jackpot prize winning plays in all participating lotteries. The Grand Prize/Jackpot amount is estimated and will be paid out in thirty (30) graduated annual installments, unless otherwise authorized per the Powerball Group Rules.

Power Play Description: The Powerball Power Play promotion is a limited extension of the Powerball game and is conducted in accordance with the Powerball game rules and other lottery rules applicable to the Powerball game except as may be amended in the Powerball Group Rules. The promotion will offer to the owners of a qualifying play a chance to multiply or increase the amount of any of the lump sum Set Prizes won in a drawing held during the promotion. The Grand Prize jackpot is not a Set Prize and will not be multiplied or increased by means of the Power Play promotion. Except as provided in the Powerball Group Rules, a qualifying play which wins one of the seven lowest lump sum Set Prizes (excluding the Match 5+0 prize) will be multiplied by the number selected, either two, three, four, five, or ten (2, 3, 4, 5, or 10), in a separate random Power Play drawing announced during the official Powerball drawing show. The 10X multiplier is only in play when the Jackpot is one hundred fifty million dollars (\$150,000,000) or less. The Powerball Group may modify the multiplier features for special promotions from time to time. The Match 5+0 prize for players selecting the Power Play option is two million dollars (\$2,000,000) unless a higher limited promotional dollar amount is announced by the Group. The Powerball Group may modify the multiplier features for special promotions from time to time.

Power Play Qualifying Play: A qualifying play is any single Powerball play for which the player pays an extra dollar for the Power Play option.

In certain rare instances, the Powerball set prize amount may be less than the amount shown. In such case, the eight (8) lowest Power Play Prizes will be changed to an amount announced after the draw. For example, if the Match 4+1 Powerball set prize amount of \$50,000 becomes \$25,000 under the rules of the Powerball game and a 5X Power Play multiplier is selected, then the Power Play prize amount would be \$125,000.

Cancellations: Powerball tickets cannot be cancelled.

19. Pick 3 Game Description

Game Name: Pick 3

Retail Sales Price: \$1

Play Style: 3 numbers from 0 to 9 each

Prize Structure: The following table sets forth the probability of winning in each prize category, based upon the total number of possible combinations in Pick 3.

*Straight/Box prize for "STR" includes prize for Straight win of \$250 plus Box win of \$80/\$40.

Drawings: Pick 3 drawings are held twice a day seven (7) days per week from Sunday through Saturday but may be changed at the discretion of the CEO.

Expected Prize Payout: Except as provided in these rules, all prizes awarded shall be paid as set prizes. The prize expense for Pick 3 is recognized as prizes are won for that draw.

Cancellations: Pick 3 tickets cannot be cancelled.

Limitation on Liability: Liability limits for any straight play number combination will be a maximum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000), or as may otherwise be set at the discretion of the CEO, for any one drawing. Once the maximum is reached for any straight play number combination, the gaming system will no longer accept that straight play number combination for that drawing. A terminal message will indicate that the liability limit has been reached and the wager has been rejected.

20. Raffle Game Description

The NMLA may offer from time to time Raffle games that are similar in play style but unique in name, price, and prize structure. Each game will follow the rules established in this document as well as the individual procedures established for that particular Raffle game. In addition, the Lottery may offer from time to time a second chance drawing in which a coupon may be printed with the sale of each Raffle game ticket. Players would then submit the coupon for a chance to win merchandise prizes or other prizes.
